

South Carolina Six Month Equine Event Permit

- The permit allows movement of Equine for up to six (6) months between the thirteen (13) southeastern states with a valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) and current EIA test.
- In South Carolina, Equine Event Permit applications **must** be obtained from your veterinarian.
- Valid for movement between Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia, and West Virginia only.
- A valid CVI. Normally the CVI is valid for thirty (30) days from the inspection date, however when accompanied with the Equine Event Permit, this CVI is now valid for six (6) months.
- A valid Equine Infections Anemia (EIA) test (Coggins test). The EIA test is valid for one year from the test date.

The event permit is valid for six (6) months from the date of issue or the expiration of the Coggins, whichever comes first.
