Approval of Minutes from November 12, 2021:

LaToya made a motion to approve the minutes from November 12, 2021, and it was seconded by Harrison. The motion passed and the minutes were approved.

Financial Update:

The CBE budget for FY22 is \$6,200 from E&G, \$3,750 of Foundation funds, and \$1,500 for Kwanza vending (\$11,450 total). In July 2021, the CBE spent \$272.69 on a Commissioner's retirement celebration and \$69.90 on a retirement gift. No money was spent since the CBE's November 2021 meeting. Thus, the current remaining budget is still \$11,107.41. There are plans to spend around \$150.00 for award plaques in January 2022.

 - i. Faculty Mentoring Program The Office of the Provost will also be offering a mentoring program for all professors. Wants to make a clear path for associate professors, so they have a clear path to tenure. They will be applying for a grant through Tiger Advance to better educate Black, female associate professors. Harrison brought up a concern regarding the difficulty disparity between Black assistant professors and Black associate professors. He encouraged more research to solidify concerns rather than act based on assumptions.
 - ii. Faculty Writing Retreat Will be partnering with the Commission on Latino Affairs. Wants the retreat to take place somewhere near Asheville, NC shortly after May 2022 graduation. Wants to keep prices below \$500.00 and the CBE expressed interest in financially sponsoring a meal. Will be reaching out to Matthew to create a "save the date" graphic.

- A. Associate and Ex-Officio Members Alesia presented proposed language to amend the constitution and bylaws. The associate and ex-officio members will have no voting power. At any point, there will be no more than five associate members. These members will be able to apply for an opening in the CBE on an annual basis.
