- Most fees for this program are covered by special funds. These fees include your flight and Visa

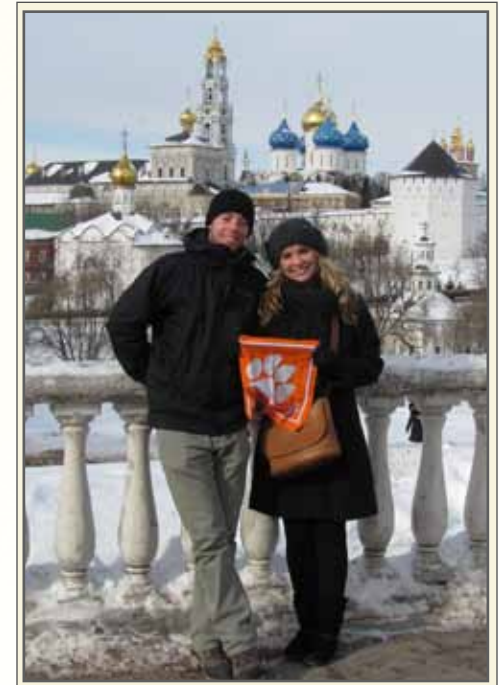

# Russian/American Study Abroad Program 2012



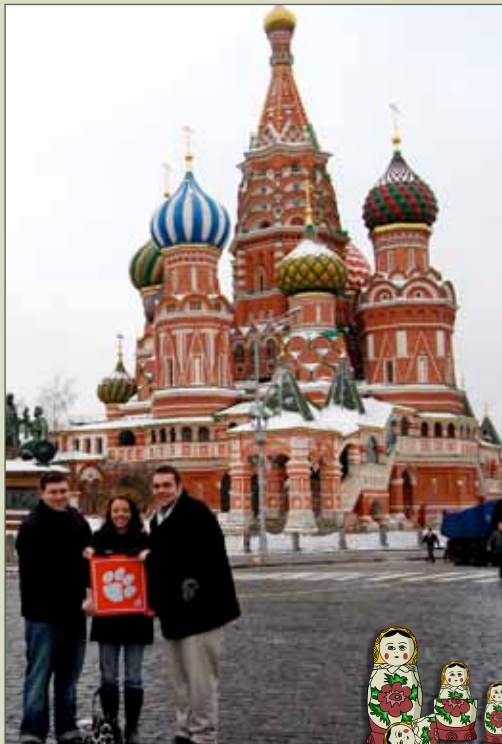
