- Car Parking: Parking Passes For Personal Cars Are Available Through Tim Bourret. Crew Parking Will Be In Lot 11. Please Note That Parking Inside The Stadium On Game Day Will Be Strictly Monitored. For Detailed Information Please Contact Tim.
- Directions: From Greenville/Spartanburg (GSP) Airport take I-85 South To Exit 19B (Hwy 76 West)
Take Hwy 76 West Toward Clemson
Go Approximately 12.5 miles
Turn Left on Perimeter Road just past the National Guard Armory (Follow Orange Signs Directing You To The Stadium)
Go To The 2nd Stoplight
Turn Right onto Williamson Road
Go Up The Big Hill To The Stop Sign
Go Straight Through And Go Down The Big Hill
The Stadium Is On Your Left
- From Atlanta Take I-85 North into South Carolina
Take Exit 14 (Hwy 187)
Turn Left At The Top Of The Exit Ramp Toward Pendleton & Clemson
At The End Of Hwy 187 Turn Left Onto Hwy 76 West Toward Pendleton
Go Approximately 4.5 Miles On Hwy 76
Turn Left At The Stoplight For Perimeter Road Just Past The National Guard Armory (Follow Orange Signs Directing You To The Stadium)
Go To The 2nd Stoplight
Turn Right onto Williamson Road
Go Up The Big Hill To The Stop Sign
Go Straight Through And Go Down The Big Hill
The Stadium Is On Your Left
- Basic Information: Announce Booth And Home Sideline Are On The South Side
Visitor Sideline Is On The North Side
"The Rock" Is In The East Endzone
The Locker Rooms Are In The West Endzone

Local Hospital: The Closest Hospital To Clemson Is Oconee Memorial. It Is Located At 298 Memorial Drive In Seneca, SC. For More Information – www.oconeememorial.org

Mobile Unit Parking: Enter Through Gate 1 On The East Side Of The Stadium. Trucks **MUST** Park Next To the Concrete Retaining Wall. Please Note That This Area Is An Emergency Access Route And The Fire Marshall Will Not Allow Any Vehicles To Block This Driveway.

8' Wide Trucks Can Park Next To The Pre-Existing Cabling Area. Expanding Trucks Will Need To Park In The Deeper Part Of The Parking Area Closer To Gate 1 If Their Steps Do Not Come Out Of The Ends Of The Truck.

Uplink Parking: Enter Gate 1 From The East Side. Parking Is On The Asphalt Behind The Concourse. The Uplink Truck Will Hit Different Satellites From Different Parts Of This Parking Area. Contact Rick Bagby From Clemson The Week Of The Game So That He Can Reserve The Appropriate Location. Trucks **MUST** Park Next To the Concrete Retaining Wall. No Vehicles Will Be Allowed To Block This Driveway Area.

Office Trailer: All Office Trailers MUST Fit Next To The Concrete Retaining Wall Just Like a TV Truck. Gate 1 Is A Very Tight Entrance. Please Make Sure Your Office Trailer Is No Wider Than A Normal TV Truck.

EAST ENDZONE CABLES

Absolutely **NO** Cables Are Allowed On The Ground In Front Of “The Hill” In The East EndZone Until After The Clemson Team Makes Its Entrance. No Trenching, Mats, Etc Are Allowed To By-Pass This Area. The Entrance To The Field At The Base Of “The Hill” **MUST** Stay Unobstructed.

Directions To High End Zone

Take The West End Zone Concourse To Section W Directly Behind The Goal Post.
 Follow The Stadium Signs For Gate 11/Elevator.
 Flow Around To Your Right Behind The Concession Stand and Look For The Door Labeled **312 Concession**
 Enter This Door And Take Elevator # 4 To Level 4
 Exit The Elevator To Your Left And Enter The Club Level Section
 Turn Immediately To Your Left And Enter Through The Woodworking Into Stairwell #5
 Take The Stairs Up One Level To The Roof.

****Please Note:** No Cases Should Be Stored On The Roof

****Also Note:** If Walking To The Roof Without Equipment You May Enter Stairwell #5 At The Double Doors Beside The 312 Concession Entrance. This Will Possibly Be Faster On Game Day.

Notes On Power:

1. Connections Have A 1000 Amp Main Breaker. This Breaker Feeds a 300k VA Transformer That Supplies 833 AMPS Secondary. 833 AMPS Is The Maximum Amount Of Power That Can Be Provided By This Transformer.
2. Clemson’s In-House PawVision Truck Will Utilize A 5th Power Connection That Is Not Listed Above. Of the 833 AMPS, This Truck Will Utilize 100 AMPS.
3. Network TV Has Priority On The 4 Connections Listed Above. Any Unused Connections May Be Provided To Additional Networks If Needed.
