



FACULTY POSITION

The Department of Mechanical Engineering at Clemson University is seeking outstanding individuals to fill a position at the Assistant/Associate Professor (tenure track) level. Primary consideration will be given to candidates with a strong research record in state-of-the-art automotive systems and their integration, focusing on engine and powertrain research. Candidates should have the potential to support and contribute to the newly-formed graduate program in Automotive Systems Integration at the Clemson University International Center for Automotive Research (CU-ICAR). The successful candidate will teach both undergraduate and graduate courses, develop a strong funded research program and have strong interactions with the CU-ICAR industrial partners. Researchers at CU-ICAR conduct cutting edge and applied research in vehicle design, manufacturing, systems/platform integration, and vehicle electronics to meet the automotive industry needs. A Ph.D. is required. Industrial experience and a track record of research applied to the automotive sector is desirable.

The Department of Mechanical Engineering currently has 32 full time tenure track faculty positions and has vigorous industry and government supported research programs. The graduate program in Automotive Systems Integration has been funded through a unique public-private partnership. This multi-disciplinary initiative involves a number of core faculty, including 4 endowed chairs. The program is housed in a new 90,000 sq. ft. building equipped with state-of-the-art facilities including major vehicle test laboratories.
