

CURRICULUM -- Current

Students with any undergraduate degree are eligible for acceptance into the Masters of Architecture program. Those without a undergraduate background in architectural design attend Summer Session 2 prior to CURRICULUM ONE. Students are required to take 9 credits in the Summer consisting of Arch 840 Skills Studio and Arch 810 Visualization / Representation 1.

Students holding a four-year BA or BS in Architecture (or equivalent) are eligible for admission to the Masters of Architecture with advanced standing, standing to be determined upon application for admission. Requirements are: at least four semesters of architectural design and courses in architectural technology such as structures and construction (please supply course outlines in the application portfolio). Requirements for the Master of Architecture degree include at least 60 credits of approved course work with a minimum grade point average of 3.0. (see CURRICULUM TWO below)

Undergraduate students can apply in their Junior year for the 3+3 Option. They are required to take CURRICULUM ONE except substituting the 4th-year BA Arch sequence consisting of, in the Fall, the Studio Requirement and, in Spring, ARCH 452 Synthesis Studio in place of Core Studios 1 and 2.

All others take CURRICULUM ONE .
