J-1 Exchange Visitor Medical Insurance Requirements

To maintain your J-1 status within the U.S., you *and any J-2 dependents* must maintain health insurance that meets the <u>minimum requirements</u> as defined by the US Department of State. Please review the table below that provides links to some insurance providers and their eligible J insurance policies. This table is meant to be a resource, and the information cannot be guaranteed, as insurance policies and plans can change without notification. You must contact these companies directly to inquire about coverage and rates and to apply for insurance. You are encouraged to use one of the plans listed below or find another option that meets the <u>minimum requirements</u>. Please provide the Insurance Explanation of Benefits when you <u>check in</u> with the IS Office and if you extend your J-1 program.

Clemson Employees: Please note that Clemson's employee insurance (PEBA) **does not** meet the minimum J-1 insurance requirements, as its deductible exceeds \$500 and does not include medical evacuation and repatriation coverage. J-1 scholars can still take advantage of certain benefits such as dental and life insurance even if they decline the medical insurance coverage. J-1 scholars are encouraged to pursue one of the options below.

- 1. Decline PEBA coverage and purchase an insurance plan that meets the <u>minimum J-1 insurance requirements</u>.
- 2. Enroll in PEBA to use as the primary insurance **and** purchase a separate insurance plan that meets the <u>minimum J-1 insurance</u> <u>requirements</u>.
