

Mechanical Engineering Arts & Humanities and Social Science Requirements:

The requirements of the Mechanical Engineering Department are the same as Sections V - VIII of the University General Education Policy, except that the most engineering programs, including ours, require **a minimum total of 15 hours (5 courses) of arts & humanities and social sciences (AH/SS)** rather than the 12 hours required by the University. The table below will assist in selecting courses to satisfy the requirements of this policy. Note that the courses listed will change over time as new courses are added and old ones are deleted (SEE ONLINE CATALOG FOR LATEST LISTINGS).

On the next page, **please read the headings over the columns and at the left side of the rows**. This should make it easy to understand which courses satisfy which requirements. The right-most column is included ONLY because some students will be under the mistaken impression that these courses will satisfy one or our 5 AH/SS. As the heading says, the courses in the right-most column provide ONLY STS or CCA credit, not AH/SS. Students who have already satisfied the 5-course requirement but have not attained the STS or CCA credit are free to take the courses in the right-most column as extra courses just to achieve the STS or CCA credit. Of course there are many courses that satisfy AH/SS **and** STS or CCA requirements, and these are the courses students should select most of the time. Requests for exceptions to these requirements will no longer be approved.
