A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE DESIGNATION OF THE CLEMSON UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONAL CENTER FOR AUTOMOTIVE RESEARCH AS A SUSTAINABLE RESEARCH CENTER.

WHEREAS, Clemson University has embarked on an ambitious initiative with corporate partners to establish the Clemson University International Center for Automotive Research in Greenville which will spotlight university commitment and leadership; and

WHEREAS, the university has embarked upon the Sustainable Universities Initiative with the other research universities in the state which fundamentally supports the principles of sustainable design, and

WHEREAS, the university has completed a master plan for the university that incorporates long-term sustainability concepts related to campus planning and building design and practice, and

WHEREAS, this focus is consistent with the university's mission statement and "road map" to make the university a national leader in innovation and in the area of environment and sustainability;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Clemson University Environmental Committee strongly supports the incorporation of sustainable site development, design, building construction and operation practices at the Clemson University International Center for Automotive Research to serve as a model for appropriate development, technology and practice within the state of South Carolina and for university research centers around the country. The committee also encourages the University and its research partners to give every possible consideration to LEED certification at the Silver level for projects associated with Clemson University.
