REQUIREMENTS

1. **GOAL** - Provide a market for open, high quality, heavy and ready-to-breed South Carolina raised replacements heifers that have been calfhood vaccinated for brucellosis.
2. Consignor must be a member of the South Carolina Cattlemen's Association.
3. Producers may consign as many heifers as they would like in uniform groups of 2-5 heifers - based on size and color.
4. **Birth Dates - September 1, 2006 thru February 28, 2007.**
5. South Carolina bred and owned by November 1, 2006.
6. Heifers must be clearly identified by ear tag and have permanent identification of a tattoo or brand.
7. Heifers must be **OPEN**.
8. Heifers must be polled or dehorned and healed when inspected in December.
9. After nomination, heifers will be inspected on the farm by an Clemson Extension Animal Scientist or the SCCA Executive Director for quality, muscling, structural soundness, disposition and body condition score.
10. **Minimum Delivery Weight Requirements**
 - 75+% **British breeding - 725 lbs.**
 - 50+% **Continental, Brahman and Brahman-based breeding - 775 lbs.**
11. The following are the herd health requirements:
 - A. **Prewearing (3-4 months-old)**
 - 1) Vaccinations - IBR, PI₃, 5-Way Leptospirosis, 7-Way Blackleg (Clostridials)
 - 2) Dewormed and treated for flies, grubs and lice
 - B. **Weaning**
 - 1) Vaccinations - IBR, PI₃, BVD, BRSV (*preferably modified live vaccine*), 5-Way Leptospirosis, 7-Way Blackleg (Clostridials), **Calfhood Brucellosis vaccination - by veterinarian**
 - 2) Dewormed and treated for flies, grubs and lice
 - C. **Yearling - by January 15, 2008**
 - 1) Vaccinations - IBR, PI₃, BVD, BRSV (*preferably modified live vaccine*), 5-Way Leptospirosis, Vibriosis
 - 2) Dewormed and treated for lice

The heifers were pregnancy checked on the farm by a veterinarian within the last 30 days. Pregnant heifers were automatically rejected. They were screened again and weighed when delivered on February 2nd.
