The training for presentations is intended for Juniors (ages 9-13) but most Cloverbuds (ages 5-8) should be able to understand the content and are welcome to participate. Seniors (ages 14-19) who are not familiar with presentations will also find this training appropriate and useful. Because speeches are a higher level of difficulty, the training for speeches is intended only for Seniors.
