4-H South Carolina 4-H has announced April 30 as its deadline to register for the 4-H FACE for WILDLIFE program. Complete details and entry form attached. The purpose of this program is to educate 4-H youths of South Carolina on the proper techniques of food plot establishment to benefit small game and other wildlife species.

4-H March 27th is a statewide youth turkey hunting day. Any youth 17 years of age or under may turkey hunt in the company of an adult 21 years of age or older. The youth does have to have turkey tags in his/her name, which are free. This is for both private lands and most public WMA areas. Check your local WMA regulations for confirmation as some special WMA's are excluded. This is a great opportunity to introduce a youth to the art of turkey hunting and to just spend some time outdoors with a young person.

4-H Both the State 4-H Sporting Clay shoot and the 4-H Skeet/Trap shoot will be held in conjunction with the SCYSF and SCTP state shoots. The Sporting Clay event will be held on May 8 at Backwoods Quail Club in Georgetown, SC and the Skeet/Trap event will be held May 22 at Mid-Carolina Gun Club in Orangeburg, SC.
