



Greenville 4-H Photography Contest

Calling all photographers! Have a favorite place in the county that you've captured on camera? Have a great pic you took of your family pet or the latest sunset that you think is great? Submit it to the Greenville Extension office to participate in the first annual Greenville 4-H Photography Contest.

Deadline: November 30th, 2009

Entry: Participants can submit 2 photographs, mounted on 8"x10" cardboard/cardstock

Age Groups: 1st-3rd grade, 4th-5th grade, 6th-8th grade, 9-12th grade

Rules:

- A single photograph or digital photo will be accepted. No collages may be submitted. Photos may be in color or black and white.
- Photos must have been taken within the last year, in Greenville County.
- Photo must not be edited, altered or digitally enhanced.
- If you are submitting non-digital photos, have the pictures developed onto a CD to include with your photo submissions. This will allow for better picture quality if we enlarge your photo for display purposes.
- With each photo submitted, a completed entry form must be securely attached to the back of the photo/cardstock. Digital photos must include a CD with the saved image. Incomplete entries will not be judged.
- Photos must have a title. However, the title does not need to appear on the front of the picture.
- All entries must be received by the Greenville Extension office no later than 4:30pm, Monday, November 30, 2009.
- Final awards will be announced by January 15, 2010.
