**Concessions on Grounds**

### General Rules and Regulations

1. Purebred cattle must be registered with their National Breed Association. Registration papers must be in the name of the exhibitor. Beef cattle not registered will be entered in the crossbred classes.
2. Exhibitors must have owned his/her animals at least 45 days prior to the date of the show.
3. Exhibitors must provide feed and water pails for their animals' exhibits and keep their animals and area clean and presentable at all times.
4. Animals will be released after the completion of each show. **There will be no removal of animals while the shows are in progress.** Any exhibitor removing animals without official releaser or before release time forfeits all prize monies or awards they have won.
5. No vehicles will be allowed to park adjacent to any of the cattle barns. Exhibitors will unload their supplies and move all vehicles to designated parking areas.
6. Livestock Superintendents will rule on all matters not covered by these or other department rules.
7. Livestock Show entry fee of \$5.00 per animal is due with Entry Form, if possible. If not, entry fee must be paid the day of the show at check-in, before any animals are shown. Horse Show entry fees are indicated on the Entry Forms. Make checks payable to Ninety Six 4-H Horse Club.
8. Each exhibitor will receive a free t-shirt. Additional t-shirts may be pre-ordered for \$10.00 each.
9. **Entry Forms MUST be received by 5:00pm on September 25, 2009. No late entries will be accepted.** All requested information must be completed for each Entry Form per exhibitor for each show entered. **Mail, email or fax entries to: Billie Miller, 650 Kirksey Pitts Rd, Troy, SC 29848, [bdmiller@emerald.com](mailto:bdmiller@emerald.com), Facsimile: 864-223-1787 Questions: 864-942-0498**
10. Exhibitors must show their OWN animal in the SHOWMANSHIP class.
11. Any exhibitor using abusive or excessive force with their animal as determined by the Livestock Superintendents will be asked to leave the premises and forfeit any premium money.
12. A breed must have, at a minimum, five animals for a breed show and to compete for Grand or Reserve Champion.
13. Each exhibitor must assume all risks in showing his/her animals. The sponsoring groups assume NO responsibility in case of fire or accident, but every reasonable precaution to prevent damage by fire or accident will be taken.
14. Exhibitor ages are determined as of **January 1, 2009.**
15. All Livestock Shows will follow 4-H Rules and Guidelines.

#### HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

All livestock should be free of any signs of infectious or contagious diseases. ALL HORSES ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST WITHIN 12 MONTHS.

It is strongly encouraged that all cattle should be vaccinated for respiratory disease (shipping fever), specifically IBR, PI3, BRSV and Pasteurella, not sooner than 6 months and not less than 2 weeks prior to the show.

#### **PROPER SHOW ATTIRE IS EXPECTED.**

Livestock: Collared, tucked-in shirt (with no logos) and long pants.

Horse: Appropriate to your discipline.

# MEAT GOAT SHOW

Thursday, October 8, 2009

Check-in: 4:30pm

Judging: 6:00pm

## Rules and Regulations:

1. Animals will be received the day of the show.
2. **Project goats will be weighed-in from 4:30-5:30pm on the day of the show. Scales will be closed promptly at 5:45pm. Any goats not weighed-in will not be permitted to show.**
3. Exhibitors must furnish feed and water pails for their animals.
4. Exhibitors must show his/her own meat goat in Showmanship classes.
5. Showmanship classes are based on participants' age as of January 1, 2009.
6. The meat goat wether and doe classes are open to SC 4-H/FFA Meat Goat Wether Project participants ONLY.
7. Each child may show only 1 doe per class.
8. Market classes will be determined according to weights at check-in.
9. **Facilities are limited. Prepare animal prior to arrival.**

- G1: Showmanship – ages 5 and under, Toddler
- G2: Showmanship – ages 6-8, Novice
- G3: Showmanship – ages 9-13, Junior
- G4: Showmanship – ages 14-19, Senior
- G5-9: Market Class I-V
- G10: Spring Weanling Doe – born 3-1-09 to present
- G11: Fall Doe – born 9-1-08 to 2-28-09
- G12: Yearling Doe – born 8-30-07 to 8-30-08
- G13: Grand Champion

## Rules and Regulations:

1. The dairy show starts at 5:00pm on Friday, October 9, 2009.
2. Dairy cattle must be in place by 3:30pm on Friday, October 9, 2009 and remain on exhibit until after the completion of the show.
3. Jersey, Guernsey and Holstein classes will be shown. All breeds will compete together in the Showmanship classes.
4. Animals must be shown by their owner in Showmanship classes. The only exception to this will be the Toddlers and Novice Classes. Showmanship ages are determined as of January 1, 2009.
5. There will be a special competition for a Supreme Champion Dairy Animal.
6. Facilities are limited. Prepare animal prior to arrival.

# BEEF SHOW

Saturday, October 10, 2009

Check-in: 9:00am

Judging: 10:00am

## Rules and Regulations:

1. The beef show starts at 10:00 am on Saturday, October 10, 2009. Beef heifers and steers must be in place by 9:00am on Saturday, October 10, 2009 and will be released at the completion of the show.
2. Zebu, Hereford, Gelbvieh, Angus, Simmental, Red Angus, Short Horn, Charolais, Crossbreds and Steer will be shown. Each breed of heifers will show separately.
3. A breed must have, at a minimum, five animals for a breed show and to compete for Grand or Reserve Champion.
4. Steers will be weighed prior to the show. Classes will be split based on entries with a maximum of 3 weight classes.
5. Showmanship classes will be shown with all breeds combined. Heifers or steers are eligible for Showmanship classes. Showmanship ages are determined as of January 1, 2009.
6. Animals must be shown by his/her owner in Showmanship classes. The only exception will be the Toddler and Novice Classes.
7. We will show animals clipped and cleaned with no fitting.
8. There will be a special competition for a Supreme Champion Beef Heifer.
9. Facilities are limited. Prepare animal prior to arrival.

## Directions

**From Greenwood:** From the intersection of Hwys 25, 221 and 72 at the Food Lion and Exxon, follow Hwy 25 south toward Edgefield for approx. 10.5 miles. Turn left onto Kirksey Pittsburgh Road and travel approx. 2.5 miles. Falling Star Training Center will be on the right just before you come to the first stop sign on this road.

**From Saluda:** Take Hwy 378 out of Saluda for approx. 11 miles. Turn right at Jct 430 onto Goldmine Road. Turn right at 3<sup>rd</sup> paved crossroad (approx. 7 miles) onto Kirksey Pittsburgh Road. Falling Star Training Center is on the left.

**From Edgefield:** Take Hwy 25 north toward Greenwood for approx. 17 miles. Turn right onto Brocker Road and travel approx. .7 miles. Take the first left onto Mountain Creek Road and travel approx. 1.2 miles. Turn left onto Kirksey Pittsburgh Road. Falling Star Training Center is the first driveway on the left.

**IMPORTANT:** Some GPS systems require that you put in the town of Ninety Six or possibly Kirksey in order to get accurate directions. **DO NOT PUT IN THE TOWN OF TROY OR YOU WILL END UP 40 MINUTES AWAY IN ANOTHER TOWN!**
