With the depressed markets of today, land-owners are searching for alternative sources of income from their forestlands.

A workshop called *Income Alternatives from Forest Lands* will be held on October 20, 2009 at the Edisto Research and Education

Center and will explore a number of possible options that can diversify revenue for land-owners, including carbon markets and emerging bio-fuel markets. This program is designed to introduce foresters and landowners to alternative timber management strategies and potential financial

benefits.

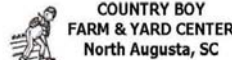

## Grass Masters Workshop: Develop a Successful Pasture

The Anderson, Oconee, Pickens, and Greenville County Extension Offices will be offering a four class series on the basics of forage establishment and management.
