Previous Meeting Minutes

- Drew Jeffers distributed the March 9, 2021 meeting minutes via email to all members, and asked if there were any questions.

Administrative Update

Dr. Thomas Dobbins

- Dr. Dobbins feels that Extension Senate is a great opportunity for him to connect with agents and that it serves a vital role in the organization.
- COVID-19
 - We are still going through COVID-19 operations, the emphasis is on caution and safety.
 - o Dr. Parisi has sent out test kits for county offices. This is meant as a convenience for staff members to be able to send off saliva tests.
- Cost of Living Adjustments (COLA)
 - o COLA increases went out for classified staff (administrative assistants, etc.)
 - The provost has not released additional money for unclassified staff. As soon as that money is released, he will get with PTL and DED to get those distributed.
- Budget
 - We are being cautious with the budget process for FY 21/22
 - We have a \$2.7 million increase, however we are being cautious
- Personnel matters
 - o Working on getting extension associate and specialists to market value
 - Working on reducing salary compression.
 - o Salaries tend to be hirer for new positions because we have to hire at market value
 - We are looking at how to correct salary compression of seasoned personnel.



- The university is looking at a merit based bonus system, but it only works if all employee salaries are at market value.
- o EPMS documents are being prepared for planning stages
- Asked PTL and DED to work on a merit pay system, so if and when we are allowed to do so we can implement it.
- Working to move TLP administrative assistants to FTE
- Dr. Dobbins is looking to make our Wellness and Nutrition and Wildlife and Natural Resource Initiatives are top State Legislative Priorities.
- Question by Senate member Are all COVID-19 policies on the extension employee website now? ANSWER: Yes they are all on the website and updated as information becomes available.

- District director's evaluation
 - o Only 20% return on those.
 - o This needs to be improved, so we can provide meaningful feedback
 - o To make these effective, we need 50% return or higher
 - o Data is compiled outside the university, so it is anonymous
