


Recycling Statistics

Clemson's recycling program began in 1994. In 2005, the program had a recycling rate of 15.7%. Both the program and the recycling rate have grown substantially since then. The 2017-2018 fiscal year recycling rate was 56.7%.



Clemson's waste has increased as the university has grown. Despite this growth, landfill volumes have remained more or less the same. Recycling volumes have increased alongside the overall waste growth.
