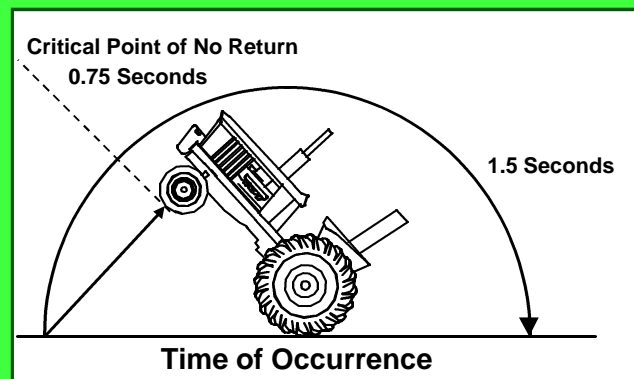
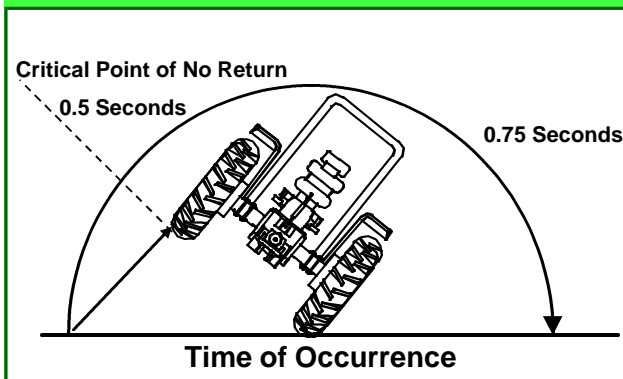


TRACTOR SAFETY

Statistics

Tractor related injuries account for approximately 270 deaths annually and nearly 11,000 nonfatal injuries each year. Three areas of concern are rollovers, runovers, and highway incidents. Rollovers account for 54 percent of the tractor related fatalities followed by runovers, 24 percent.

Runovers

Most runovers occur when an operator or extra-rider falls from the tractor. (50% of runovers)

DO NOT ALLOW EXTRA RIDERS

On ROPS tractors, Wear Your Seatbelt

**27 percent of runovers occur to bystanders.
Pay Attention to Your Surroundings**

**The other cause of runovers is starting a tractor from the ground.
Start from the Drivers Seat - Not the Ground**
