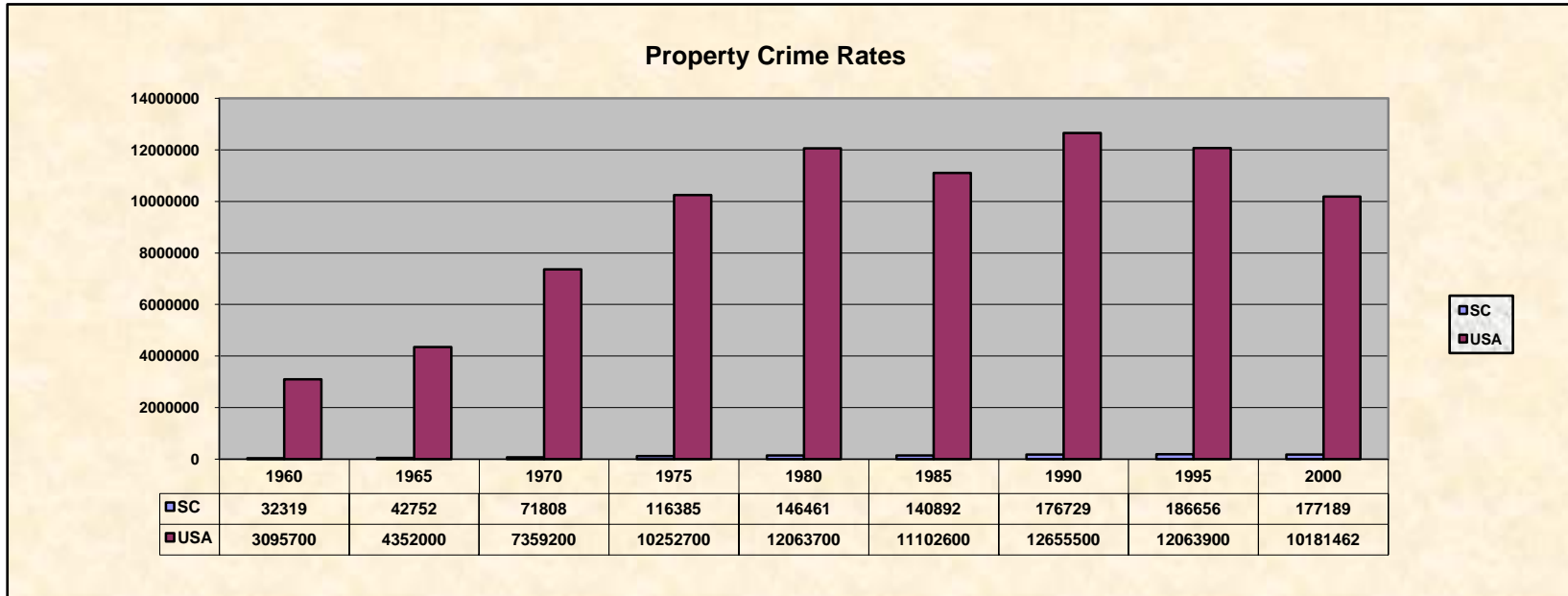


## Property Crime Rates



In the year 2000, South Carolina had an estimated population of 4,012,012, which ranked the state as having the 26<sup>th</sup> standing in population. For that year, the State of South Carolina had a total crime index of 5,221.4 reported incidents per 100,000 people. This ranked the state as having the 5<sup>th</sup> highest total crime index.

For crimes against property, the state had a reported incident rate of 4,416.5 per 100,000 people, which ranked South Carolina as having the 9<sup>th</sup> highest standing among the states.
