SPANISH major 30 credits arranged as follows:

Group I – 6 credits from SPAN 311, 313.

Group III – 6 credits from SPAN 302 or 305; 309 or 314.

Group IV – Span 409, 411, or six credits of equivalent courses abroad.

Group V - 6 credits from Span 398, 401, 403, 406, 407, 422, 498.
