### Who Should Attend

Master Wildlifer II is an advanced satellite course designed for landowners, land managers, and wildlife enthusiasts who are interested in integrating wildlife in their land use and management activities. Practicing land managers will find the course invaluable in highlighting alternative management approaches for wildlife in forest and farm settings. Special emphasis is placed on wildlife (game species) that currently offer landowners additional sources of income through recreational access fees. Course participants will obtain the knowledge and necessary tools to enhance habitat for a variety of wildlife species that can be enjoyed by themselves, family and friends, and outdoor recreationists. Master Wildlifer II is an advanced, up-to-date version of the Master Wildlifer 2003 and 2005 course and incorporates the latest research and management information from the leading experts in the field of wildlife management.


