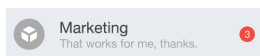

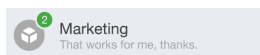
View badge



	Mute	Mute or unmute all participants
	Activate speaker	Engage the iPhone's internal speaker*
	Call	Call additional participants during a call
	Invite	Send invitation during a call
	Participant	Click to control participant's audio or video, or to remove participant
	Speaking	Participant is speaking
	Muted	Participant's audio is muted
	Presenting	Participant is presenting
	Connecting	The participant is connecting
	Participant issue	There is a problem with the participant's audio or network connection
