Subject: FOIA Requests and the South Carolina Family Privacy Protection Act.

Under the South Carolina Family Privacy Protection Act (SC Code Section 30-2-10 et seq) of 2002 no person or private entity shall obtain or use personal information obtained from a state agency for commercial solicitation directed to any person in this State. The agency is also required to notify all requesters of records that obtaining or using them for such commercial solicitation is prohibited. Finally, agencies are required to take reasonable measures to ensure that personal information obtained from public records is not used in violation of the law.

Before we can release the information you have requested, therefore, we must ask that you sign and return this memorandum. Please accept our apologies for this inconvenience.
