IMPORTANT! To be eligible for certification, foundation or registered seed must be planted. A bill of sale or invoice and certification label must accompany the application to provide evidence of the source, quantity, and class of seed. Growers planting their own registered sprigs for certified sod production must indicate which field the sprigs came from. Maps must be submitted for all fields.

I hereby apply for inspection of the crops listed and agree to abide by S.C. Seed Certification Standards. My signature to this application is affidavit of the following:

1. That information submitted for verification of seed eligibility represents the total amount of seed used and that only the seed verified as eligible seed source was planted in the fields described on this application.
2. That all equipment involved in planting, harvesting, conditioning, or other handling of said crops, was or will be cleaned to maintain purity of the crop.
3. That the identity of the crop will be maintained from harvest time to the time it leaves my possession through use of an identification system as indicated in the S.C. Seed Certification Standards.
4. That the land which this crop is planted on meets land requirements specified for "Vegetatively Propagated Turf Grasses" in the S.C. Seed Certification Standards.
