STUDENT FINANCIAL STATEMENT

If you are petitioning for release from the Terms and Conditions of your University Housing Contract because of financial hardship beyond your control, you must complete this form in addition to completing the Appeals Petition. Written documentation supporting the claim of financial hardship and proof of a lower priced anticipated alternate housing arrangement are also required. **DO NOT SIGN ANOTHER LEASE OR AGREEMENT PRIOR TO SECURING RELEASE FROM YOUR CAMPUS HOUSING OBLIGATION.**

The Appeals Committee or Appeals Officer may request additional written documentation. If you are unable to document a severe financial hardship beyond your control and anticipated alternate housing (including rent, utilities, deposits, etc.) that is lower in cost than the lowest campus housing rental space available to you, your petition will be denied. Other assistance may be offered to you including transfer to a lower priced residential space or area.
