LIB 100: Clemson Connect is a required pass/fail, zero credit course which provides all new Clemson students with the information needed for a successful transition. In order to pass this course all associated homework assignments must be completed, due dates are referenced below. Clemson Connect has five (5) components and activities in which all new freshman students will participate and submit required assignments: New Student Convocation, iClemson, One Clemson, Freshman Summer Reading, and a Library Workshop. The information below will help guide you through Clemson Connect and ensure you complete all of the required assignments in the course. **Remember Clemson Connect is one of your first courses at Clemson University; complete all the assignments to you start your semester off right!**

- After Orientation, start Clemson Connect by **accessing the course through Blackboard- <http://bb.clemson.edu>** . Towards the top of the screen select COURSES, then find LIB 100: Clemson Connect and select it.

- Access the *iClemson* video through Blackboard
 - Watch the *iClemson* video**

- Read Summer Reading book, *The Speed of Dark*
 - Complete and Submit Summer Reading Essay; Essay Due in Blackboard August 18, 2009**
 - *Submit through Blackboard>Clemson Connect Course>Assignments>Summer Reading*

- On August 1, 2009 go to Blackboard to view your Clemson Connect schedule and Welcome Leader group assignment. *Your Welcome Leader is an undergraduate upperclassman who will guide you through Clemson Connect programs. They will be available to answer your questions and help you with your transition to Clemson! You will meet your Welcome Leader at New Student Convocation.*

- Attend **Freshman Summer Reading**, Tuesday, August, 18 1:00-4:00pm, Littlejohn Coliseum
 - Print and turn-in your QQT to your small group discussion facilitator**

- Register for and attend a **Library Workshop**; Various times during fall semester, Cooper Library

 - Complete follow-up quiz**
