

Policy for Development & Review Process for Clemson Sponsored Study Abroad Programs

Proposed by International Programs Coordination Committee
Approved by Academic Council—January 30, 2017

Policy Statement:

All Clemson sponsored Study Abroad programs, including semester-long, faculty-led summer, and embedded short-term programs for which students earn Clemson academic credit, must be **approved** for implementation by the International Programs Coordinating Committee (IPCC).

The IPCC will accept **recommendations** from each college at the published deadlines and review them according to published criteria.

Prior to inclusion in the College's portfolio of recommended programs, new and repeating faculty directed study abroad programs must meet all operational requirements established by Clemson Abroad, as well as criteria set by:

- Department offering credit
- College Internationalization Committee, or other entity appointed by the Dean of the College. If sponsored by multiple colleges, review by all participating colleges/units is required.

The IPCC will not review proposals submitted directly by faculty or departments that have not been reviewed by Clemson Abroad nor recommended by sponsoring college. Program development discussions with Clemson Abroad should begin as early as possible and no later than 14 months prior to anticipated program date.
