

Data reflect student registrations, courses taught, and instructor characteristics captured at the census date for the 2019 Summer Session; these data were also reported to South Carolina's Commission for Higher Education by OIR.

Definitions

Headcount:

The total number of non-duplicative credit hours taken by all students during summer session.

Adjusted Courses:

The total number of courses taught during Summer Session excluding thesis and dissertation sections (#8910/9910).

Labs:

The total number of labs taught during Summer Session (also included in Course and Adjusted course counts).

% of Fall SCH:

The total number of summer 2019 SCH as a percentage of the previous Fall semester's (i.e., 2018) total SCH.







College by Headcount














