We are seeking applicants who are interested in working with the Global Competency Outcomes to map the current state of Global Learning within their college’s curricula and serve as advocate for Global Learning within their college.

- Tenured faculty (full professor rank preferred)
- Demonstrated leadership in curriculum design and development
- Demonstrated excellence in undergraduate teaching
- Approval of Department Chair and Dean
- Availability to travel to the AACU conference on Global Learning (Oct 17-19)
- Available to participate in Global Learning Institute (February 2020)

Appointment Duration: September 30, 2019 – February 28, 2020

Compensation: OGE will provide resources for 1 Course Release as negotiated with Fellow’s department, plus funds for registration and travel to the AACU conference.
