Start Early

Build Relationships

Craft Your Personal Statement

Gain Related Experience

Gain relevant experience through internships, creative inquiries, volunteer work, etc., that aligns with your intended field of study.

Stay Organized

Consider keeping track of application deadlines, requirements, and additional materials in a tracking document like Excel to ensure you submit everything on time and in a complete format.
