Requirements: Path, Portal, Place (aka: Healthy Place Project)

Existing Conditions aka Site Inventory and Analysis

- diagrammatic analysis
- “think again” analyses
- other examinations and research about the site and project

Conceptual Design

- 1"=20' preliminary master planning
- 1'=1'0" site planning at enlarged scale
- preliminary sections and sketches
- other new sketches, images, writings, ideas used to develop the design – site specific

Master Plans

- 1"=20' master plan
 - Labels
 - North arrow
 - Scale
 - Borders
 - Indication of sections and perspectives
 - Outstanding graphics
- 1'=1'0" enlarged site plan
 - Labels
 - North arrow
 - Scale
 - Borders
 - Indication of sections and perspectives
 - Outstanding graphics

Supplemental Drawings

- Two “Before and After” Sections of Healthy Place (total four sections)
- Two Perspectives of Health Place
- One Perspective of your Portal (the entrance or gateway to your site)
- One Perspective of your Path (the process of getting from entrance to healthy place)

Requirements: **Portfolio**

- Cover with Name, Date, A Really Cool and Hip Image or Background
- Table of Contents
- Contents include (*these are the projects to include*):
 1. Logo
 2. Amphitheatre
 3. Sketching with Additions
 4. Orthogonal Forms
 5. Circular Forms
 6. Forms Combined incl Model Images and Original, Inspirational Painting
 7. Diagrammatic Analysis (include as part of Path, Portal, Place)
 8. Path, Portal, Place (aka: Health Place Project)
- Written Reflection (150-300 words)

- Portfolio Size is 24" H x 36" W
- Pay attention to backgrounds
- Use text boxes for labeling
- Save or Export as PDF
- Submit PDF via email by due date (December 7 3pm)
