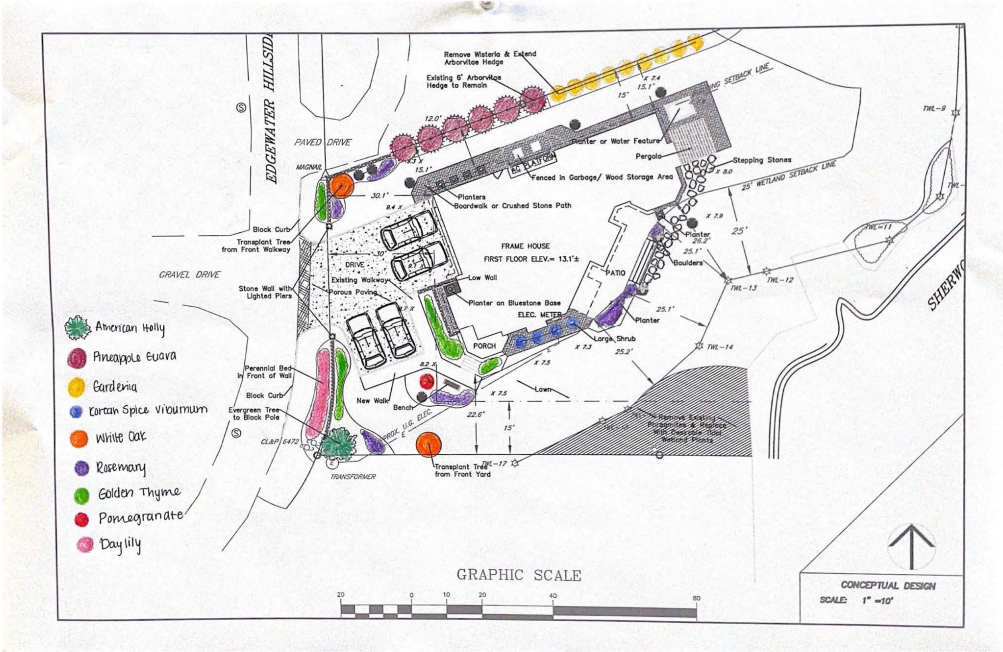

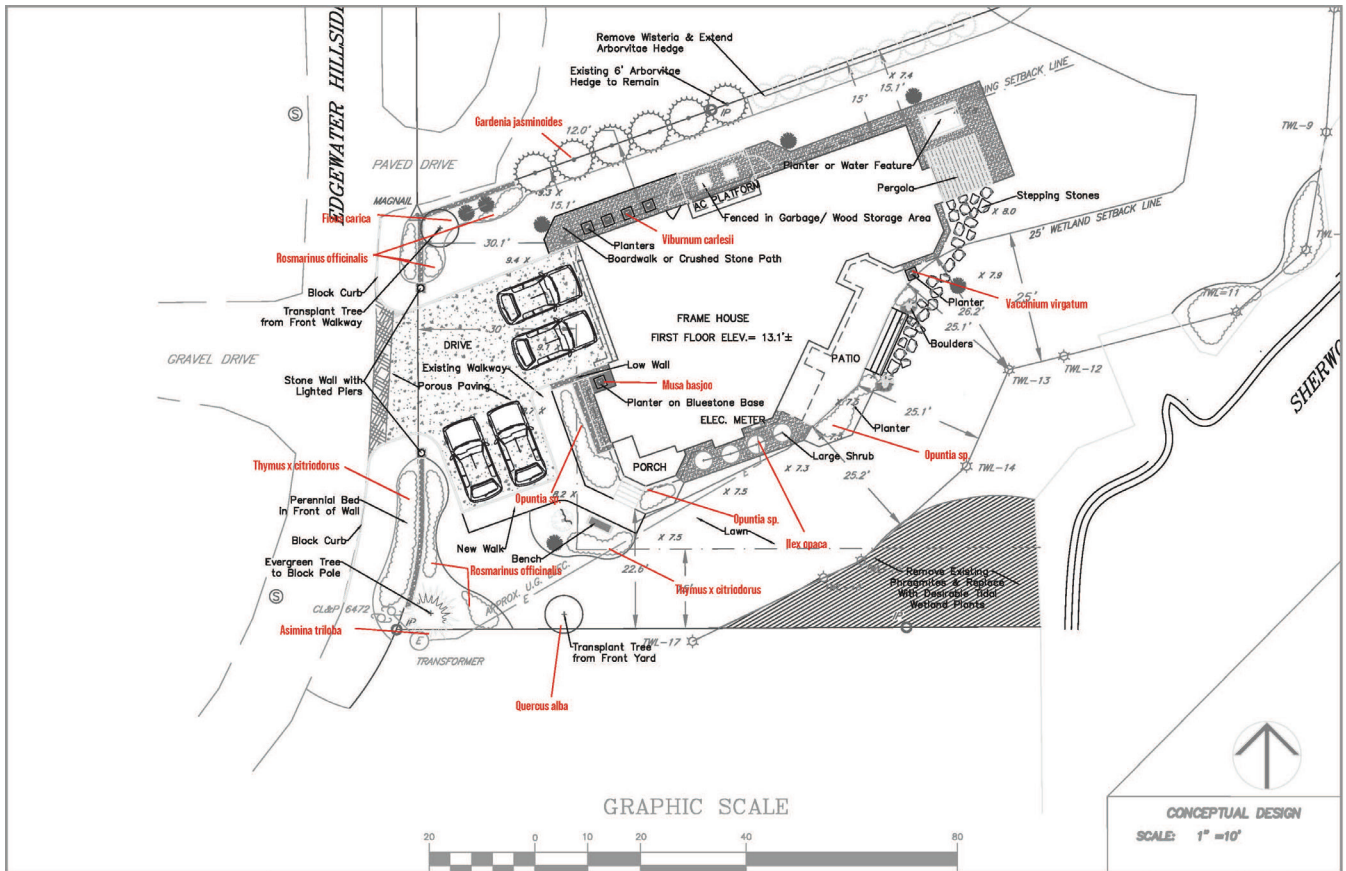

Common Name	Botanical Name	Reasoning
Paw Paw	<i>Asimina triloba</i>	Unique tree, does well by itself, acts as a screener
American Holly	<i>Ilex opaca</i>	Evergreen tree, acts as a screener, can handle wet feet
Virginia Sweetspire	<i>Itea virginica</i>	Deciduous shrub with good fall color (burgundy) that lasts well into winter, will look good beside Holly tree throughout each season, tall enough to cover wall
Flowering Dogwood	<i>Cornus florida</i>	Tree with good seasonal interest: showy flowers in spring, red fruit and green leaves in summer, & red leaves in fall.
Gardenia	<i>Gardenia jasminoides</i>	Evergreen shrub, fragrant white flower in the spring-summer (good for entry way), fruit turns orange, does well in morning sun & light afternoon sun (good because on one side of house so doesn't get full sun or full shade)
Japanese Stewartia	<i>Stewartia pseudocamellia</i>	Ornamental tree (looks good by itself), showy flowers in June, unique flower buds, good fall color.
Knockout Rose	<i>Rosa 'Knockout'</i>	Deciduous shrub, adds color to the landscape, hardy.
Pineapple Guava	<i>Acca sellowiana</i>	Edible fruit, can be in tree or shrub form, unique red flowers, tolerates full sun & heat, evergreen, dense enough to act as screen
Golden Thyme	<i>Thymus x citriodorus</i>	Edible herb, bright green groundcover - looks good between stepping stones and around boulders, small white/blue flowers, semi-evergreen
Daylily	<i>Heemerocallis</i> sp.	Multi-color, big blooms in summer to early fall - will add pop of color to landscape, clump-forming, handles air pollution, and erosion
Rabbiteye Blueberry	<i>Vaccinium virgatum</i>	Red fall color, edible blueberries in summer, little white flower in clusters
Fragrant Tea Olive	<i>Osmanthus fragrans</i>	Full sun to part shade, fragrant, acts as a screener for privacy
