For this assignment, you will create a planting plan for the Lowry Courtyard that focuses on the planting style of the environmental movement. Begin by selecting an archetype. What are the characteristics of your archetype? How can you simplify yet enhance its natural features? What plants match this environment? Start creating your plant palette.

Then think about the human needs (this should come largely from your analysis diagram) and create a design that demonstrates vertical layering. You can have group-based sections, but at least one area should represent a matrix-style planting. Identify your structure, seasonal theme, groundcover, and filler plants. These can be specified in your plant legend.

Exercise Deliverables: 1 Planting Plan (style should resemble matrix plantings similar to the examples shown to you in class) with a plant schedule and a concept statement. Please remember to upload a single pdf file of all of your drawings etc.

Submissions will be graded based on narrative, content, critical thinking, design, plant selection and graphic quality.

Graphic Quality Graphics are clear, legible, and contain the necessary components (scale, N arrow, title, plant schedule etc.). Program elements, plants and important features are labeled. Plan is graphically pleasing and matches the style requested in the project statement.		20 pts
