

Exercise # 7

Hardscape and Landscapes

The purpose of this exercise is to begin developing a visual library for hardscape and landscape materials. In addition to trees, shrubs and plant materials that are used in landscape architectural drawings this exercise will incorporate several hardscape materials. Students will select a number of appropriate hardscape materials from the lecture handout or text books. Hardscape materials should include paving materials, bricks, rocks, stone, concrete....etc .

On an 18"x24" vellum or mylar sheet use the provided plan drawing to generate your site that incorporates hardscapes and landscapes.

Scale of drawing is approximately 1" = 10'. Please provide a design to surround the planting bed in a way that includes a number of different materials, textures and patterns. Please provide a title block for your sheet. Please incorporate shade and shadow.

Exercise is to be produced in different line weights of lead.
Use lettering for your name, class, section and other information in your title block.

Use of appropriate line weights
