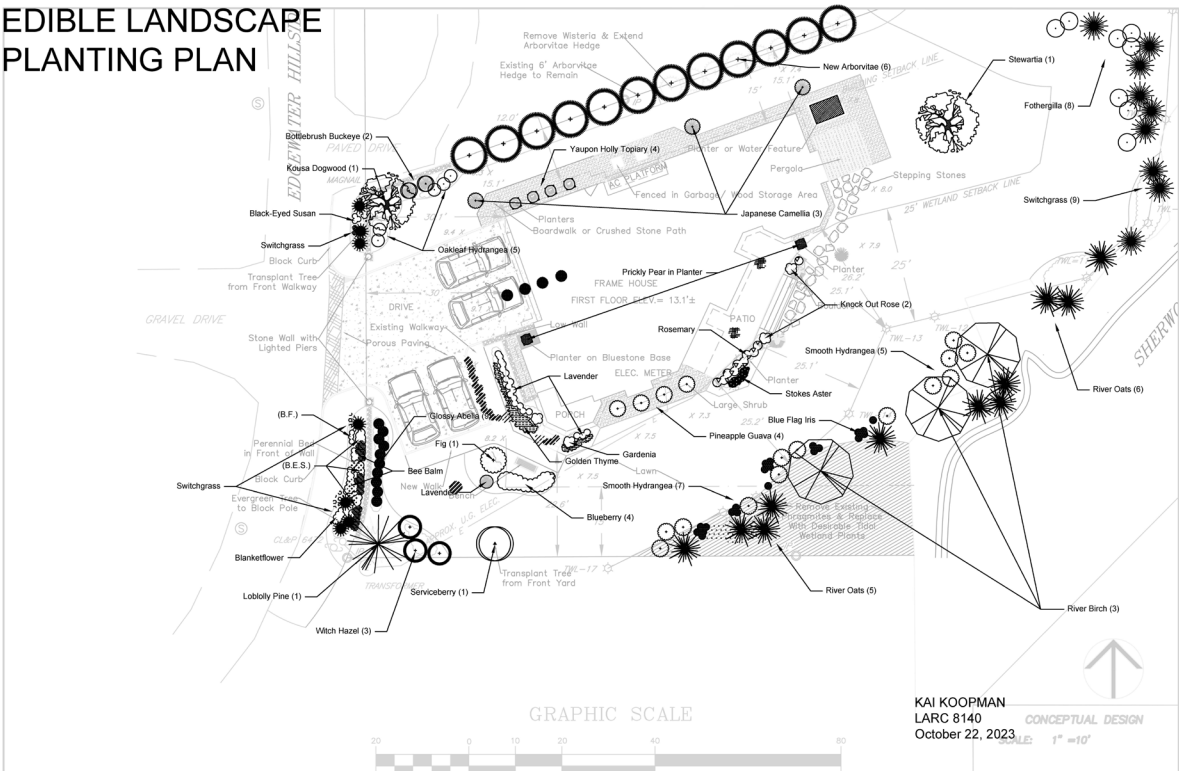

	Common Name	Botanical Name	Landscape Purpose
	Edible Fig	<i>Ficus carica</i>	Attractive leaves and fruit
	American Holly	<i>Ilex opaca</i>	Dense structure to block pole
	Lemon Thyme	<i>Thymus x citridodorus</i>	Ground cover
	Rosemary	<i>Rosmarinus officinalis</i>	Perennial, attractive fragrance, dense structure blocks wall
	Pineapple Guava	<i>Acca sellowiana</i>	Perennial evergreen shrub, tropical feel, attractive flowers
	Paw Paw/ Custard Apple	<i>Asimina triloba</i>	Fall color interer
	Hardy Banana	<i>Musa basjoo</i>	Attractive large leaves
	Gardenia/Cape Jasmine	<i>Gardenia jasminoides</i>	Attractive fragrance and white flowers
	Rabbiteye Blueberry	<i>Vaccinium virgatum</i>	Fall interest, Spring flowers
