Project 1- Landscape Architect/Architect Precedent Study

Task: To research, document, and present the assigned precedent landscape architect or architect. Research should address at a minimum:

1. Where the firm is located?
2. What are the firm's project types?
3. What size and scale do they work?
4. What materials do they use often? (select 3 or more)
5. How are the materials used?
6. What is their ecological and/or social significance?
7. What meaning(s) does their material choices convey?
8. What experience(s) does the material choices convey?
9. Defend your answers with 3 or more project precedents

Deliverable: -One (1) 24"x36" diagram/ideogram that communicates graphically your research.
The Sheet/Board should also contain a 100–250-word description.
-A nine (9) slides (2-3 min.) presentation that answers the above questions.

1. To practice researching and organizing objective and subjective data related to landscapes
2. To practice effectively communicating data graphically and verbally
3. To better understand the importance and influence of landscape architecture
4. To better understand the importance of materials and the deliberate sourcing of materials
