The deadline for applications and seed delivery is March 15, 2020.

IMPORTANT CHANGES:

- **Continued for 2020 - as crop management continues to change we feel it necessary to require that all entries must be Glyphosate resistant**
- **As Temik is no longer available we are allowing insecticide/nematicide treated seed this year. We would prefer that it was the same combination that would be applied to seed that was to be sold in South Carolina. Please indicate clearly what the seed treatment is on the application.**
- **There are 4 environments, an irrigated and non-Irrigated trial at Edisto and Pee Dee Research and Education Centers, additional on-farm trials will be conducted at locations to be determined.**
- **As a result of increasing the number of locations, the seed requirement is 8 lbs. per entry. There will be no exceptions. Submitting less than eight (8) pounds of seed may result in entries not being planted at all locations.**

Trials will be divided into early and later maturing tests.
