SUBJECT: 2020 Soybean Trials

This is an electronic version of the 2020 application for the South Carolina soybean trials. Please complete the application and email it back to me at bstanci@clermson.edu. No changes have been made in the fees for this year.

New for 2020, SC Variety testing will be offering a group 4 soybean test, note the earlier deadline date. We will plant 4 locations (Pee Dee REC, Edisto REC - irrigated, Sandhill REC, Simpson REC) of this test with 3 locations being dryland and 1 being irrigated. We will need at least 15 entries to make this feasible.

The deadline for application and seed delivery is **March 15, 2019.**

TEST COMPOSITION

The test will be divided into separate tests by maturity group (Groups IV, EV, LV, VI, VII, and VIII).

The test will consist of one large conventionally managed test with RR, LL, and other varieties unless a sufficient number of entries are received for each category to warrant dividing the test based on traits. **Please indicate if a variety is RR, LL, or etc.!**

TEST LOCATIONS – 3 REPLICATES PER LOCATION

Blackville -dry land & irrigated

Florence - dry land & irrigated

Clemson – dry land

Columbia – Group 4

FEES AND APPLICATION FORMS

There is a fee of \$500 for each entry submitted.

SEED REQUIREMENTS

All seed should be packaged in sturdy bags and shipped to the above address to arrive no later than March 15, 2020.

Fifteen (15) lbs. of seed will be required for each entry in the Test.

Treated seed must be labeled with the name of the treatment. We are requesting that you use no insecticidal seed treatment.

DO NOT INCLUDE THE NAME AGRONOMY, CROP & SOIL ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE, OR ENTOMOLOGY, SOILS, AND PLANT SCIENCES IN THE SHIPPING ADDRESS. THIS CAUSES DELIVERIES TO BE ROUTED TO THE WRONG BUILDING.
