

Part I. Requirements

United States (U.S.) Universities are required by law to verify that students entering the U.S. with temporary student visas have adequate financial resources to meet the expenses of their program of study. Please complete this form and provide supporting financial documents to receive a Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20 or DS-2019) from Clemson University, which you will use to apply for your U.S. student visa. F-1 students are required to provide supporting financial documentation that covers, at minimum, the first academic year of study while J-1 students are required to provide proof of financial documentation that covers the complete academic program. As these amounts vary based off education level and tuition tier, please view the links in Part II for additional guidance.

- Financial Support Documentation Requirements:
 - Issued within the last six months (Please note that bank statements do not need to include the entire list of transactions for the past six months. The statement just needs to reflect the summary page that confirms the account holder, statement date, and available balance.)
 - Statement must show the name of the account holder, date of the statement, and total amount of liquid (immediately available) funding
 - o Original statement in English or a translated, certified copy if statement is in another language
 - o Can come from any combination of sources, including personal, family, or sponsored funds
 - Multiple sources of funding require documentation from each source along with separate copies of the second page of this form
