Award Requirements:

Please Note:

- *No more than one event can be signed off by alumni of the chapter*
- *Documented hours should be limited to the period of January 1-December 31, 2020*
- Events do not need to be for only the fraternity/sorority community. Events can be open to all.
- Per member amounts are based on fall membership sizes
- **All donations and service hours must be verified in writing by the benefiting organization for each individual member. (Official form)**
- **Attending other chapters' philanthropy events does NOT count toward service hours, unless an actual service is performed (i.e. – adopt-a-highway clean-up)**

Scoring:

Chapter must obtain **5 out of 6 possible points** to receive this award

Criteria:

1. Chapters must have donated an average of \$15 in cash and/or in goods per member (including new members) • *points possible: 0 - 2*
2. A typed philanthropic and service program must be included in awards application
 - *points possible: 0 - 2*
3. A philanthropic service officer must be active, with a committee if one is needed
 - *points possible: 0 - 1*
4. One philanthropic or hands-on service activity must be sponsored (or co-sponsored) from January 1-December 31, 2020. This activity must be open to the fraternity/sorority community or the entire university. Virtual or social media events are acceptable. • *points possible: 0 – 1*
5. **Bonus point opportunity:** Due to Covid-19, service opportunities have been limited and therefore there is no service hours requirement this year. If your chapter has completed service hours (in spring or fall), please include a list off community service hours for your chapter. Bonus points will be added to this category as by average hour per chapter (per each semester)
 - 1 – 5 average hours per member = 1 point
 - 5 – 10 average hours per member = 2 points
