Organization and Chapter History



- Traditional Founding
 - Founded in 1400 at the University of Bologna, Italy.
 - Considered the oldest fraternity in the world.
- American Founding
 - Founded on December 10, 1869, at the University of Virginia on the four pillars of Fellowship, Leadership, Scholarship, and Service.
 - Largest collegiate fraternity in the world with over 320 chapters throughout the United States and Canada.
- Kappa-Upsilon Chapter Founding (Clemson University)
 - Founded on March 6, 1970. Currently over 115 Active Members.
 - Originally known as Kappa Sigma Nu, founded at Clemson in 1963.



Philanthropy and Service

- Service is an integral part of the Kappa-Upsilon Chapter and Kappa Sigma as a whole.
- Nationally, Kappa Sigma's main philanthropic effort is A Greater Cause: The Military Heroes Campaign, which is dedicated to supporting military veterans and their families.
- At the Kappa-Upsilon Chapter, we host our annual "Kappa Sigma Cook-Off" to support the cause. Most recently, in 2019, we raised \$16,000 to contribute.
