





 - New member fee (\$850)

- Submission of Application Packet & Fees
- Interview Process
- Candidate Evaluation Period
- 5 Educational/Development Sessions
- Testing Session
- Initiation
- Prospective Members should also keep in mind:
 - Time to study and review fraternity information
 - Time to plan community service project
 - Additional educational development time that prospective members will spend with each other.
