The International EDGE Program is a collaborative and unique approach to delivering core PRTM content to majors while in Australia for 8 weeks!! This approach allows content to be delivered in a flexible and integrative manner incorporating the use of innovative teaching methods, undergraduate research, real world experiences, and experiential learning that will prepare students to become part of the global workforce. While in Australia, students will be receiving course content with a Clemson PRTM faculty member in collaboration with faculty from a local university in Brisbane. Additionally there are two multi-day excursions outside of Brisbane to get gain first-hand knowledge of the PRTM profession in action.
