Clemson University's **Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism Management (PRTM)** is currently recruiting well-qualified Ph.D. and M.S. students to start in Fall 2023. Graduate degrees are offered either on-campus or online. Graduate students are being recruited to work in a variety of research focus areas within the context of PRTM including:

- Non-profit organizations and their operations, including leadership and effectiveness

- Tourism, tourism planning & development, and sustainable tourism, in the U.S. and abroad
- Festivals and events
- Health, wellness, and human-nature connections
- Veterans, military families and injured military service members
