

INFORMATION ABOUT HOUSING POSSIBILITIES CLOSE TO CAMPUS

There are many rental options here in Landshut to choose from. However, we recommend and will provide assistance with the following three:

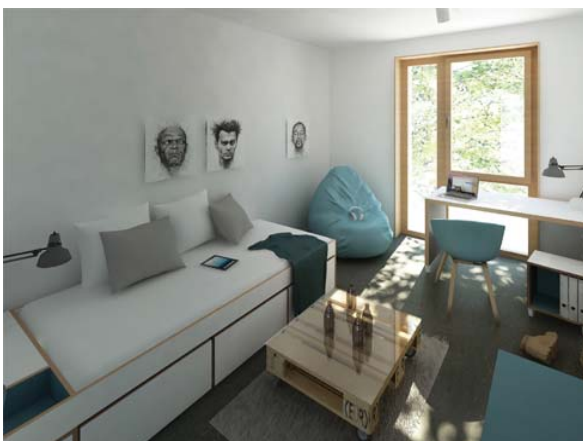
OPTION 1 – BÜRGERMEISTER-ZEILER-STRASSE 8 – 12:

Due to the increasing number of students, there is a new dormitory (first-time lease in October 2017) just across the street and next to the old dorm at Bürgermeister-Zeiler-Straße 14 – 16 (see option 3). The new dorm consists of three individual buildings, each are marked with a different color, so there's the blue, yellow and green house. It can host a total of 210 students. The new dorm offers individual rooms en suite (own toilet and shower) with own kitchen (type 1) as well as double rooms with shared bathroom and kitchen (type 2). However, please note: you need to conclude your own contract in terms of internet supply (no WiFi available!). This dorm is the best location if you prefer to be in close proximity to the university. The bus stop "Hochschule" is just a two-minute-walk and is right in front of the university. From there busses run regularly into town. The single rooms are equipped with an extended twin bed, desk and chair, wardrobe, mini fridge, and stove top with two burners (small and large). Single rooms do not have an oven!



In the bottom right corner you can see the three apartment complexes of the Studentenwerk. They are next to the old dorm and the campus grounds are within walking distance.

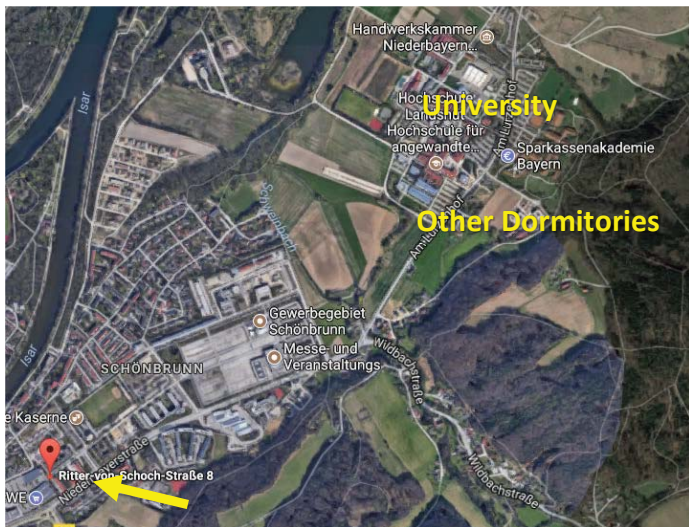

OPTION 2 – RITTER-VON-SCHOCH-STRASSE 8:

The second is the student dormitory at “Ritter-von-Schoch-Straße 8”. This dormitory is pretty new (finished in October 2015) and an ideal location to stay at. It is situated a block away from the bus stop “Alte Kaserne”, REWE and LIDL (both grocery stores), DM (convenience store), a pharmacy, a gelato shop, nail salon, restaurants, and more. The rooms are singles (type 1), 2-person shared kitchen (type 2), or 6-person shared kitchen (type 3). All rooms are private and have their own washroom. If you choose this dormitory we will place you in a single room, if you wish to be placed in another type of room you will have to contact the International Office in advance. The single rooms are furnished with an extended twin bed, desk and chair, wardrobe, mini fridge, and stove top with two burners (small and large). Single rooms do not have an oven! All rooms offer free internet access via cable (no WiFi).

The red arrow marks the location of the new student dormitory at “Ritter-von-Schoch-Straße” and at the top right corner you can see the University of Applied Sciences.



The pictures above show you the dormitory again and it marks the location of the nearest bus stop. From there it's only a short bus ride to the university. The students can use the busses free of charge (Student Card).

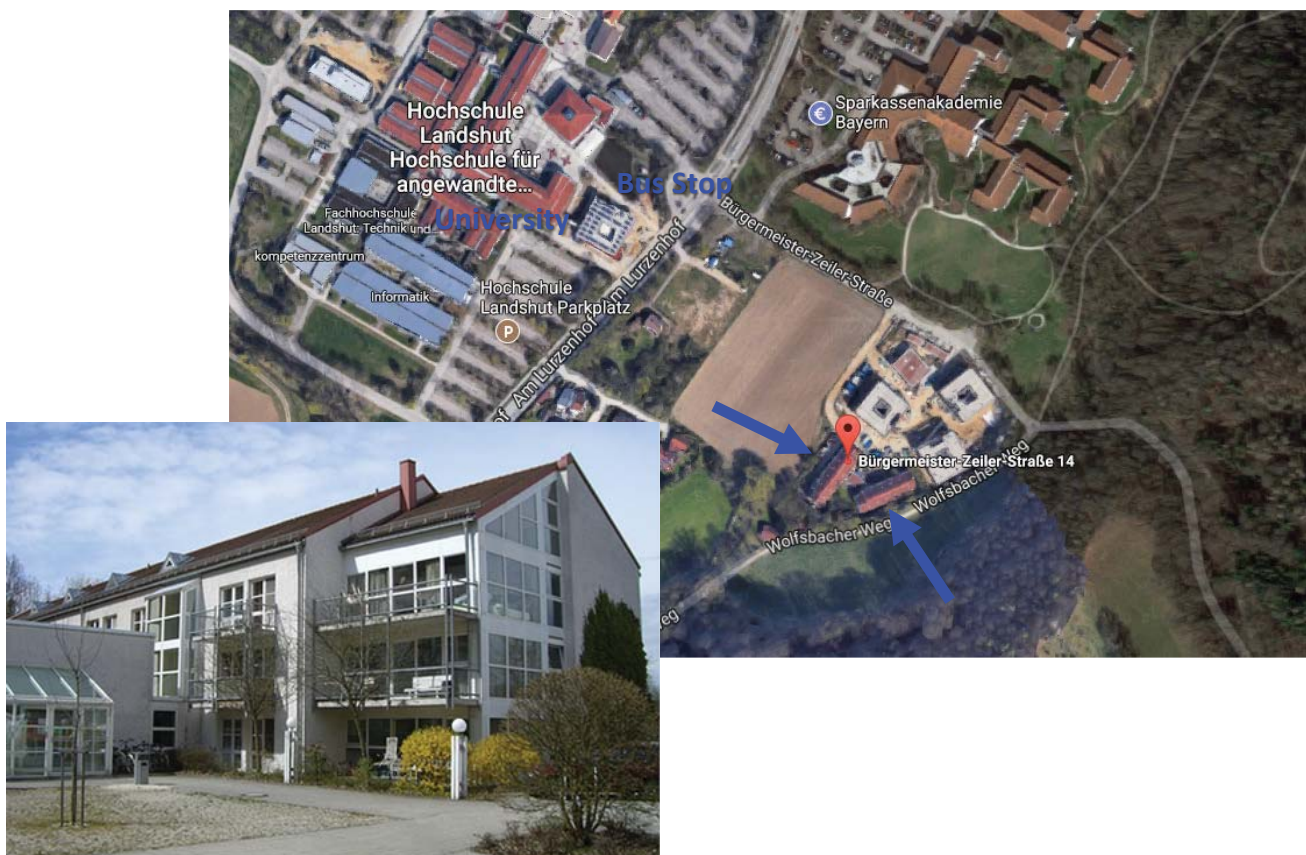


OPTION 3 – BÜRGERMEISTER-ZEILER-STRASSE 14 – 16 (II. BA):

The third is the student dormitory at “Bürgermeister-Zeiler-Straße 14-16”. This dormitory is right across the street from the university, about a 2-minute-walk to reach the university grounds and bus stop “Hochschule”. It is older and more secluded than the other dorm, but has the convenience of being close to the university. All rooms share a kitchen that is relative to your room’s location, about 6 rooms per kitchen. The rooms are furnished with an extended twin bed, desk and chair, wardrobe, and private washroom. All rooms offer free internet access via cable (no WiFi). This dorm has more of a family feel and is a good option if you like to be more social and potentially cook with other residence.

Monthly Rent:		
Type 1:	Single Room with shared kitchen	EUR 220 - 223

The red arrow marks the location of the dorm and you can see that the university (“Hochschule Landshut”) is just a stone’s throw away:



Some comments in general: all students living in one of the three dorms are required to pay a deposit of EUR 260.00 in advance, which will be reimbursed after their stay. The bedding (pillow and blanket) as well as the linens (set of sheets and pillow case) will be provided by the Studentenwerk (owner of the dormitories), but all of them have to be returned afterwards freshly cleaned (dry cleaning only).
