## **Transient Student Acknowledgement Form for Course Enrollment**

Clemson University courses offered online or in person within the Clemson University College of Engineering, Computing and Applied Sciences are designed to meet the requirements of Clemson University majors. They may or may not meet the requirements of a transient student's home institution.

Courses offered by departments within the College have established prerequisites as published in the Clemson University Catalog (<a href="http://catalog.clemson.edu/">http://catalog.clemson.edu/</a>). The syllabus for each course also lists prerequisite courses as well as prerequisites by topic. Without the knowledge from the required prerequisite courses, it may be difficult for a transient student to pass and receive credit for courses within the College. Please note that no one at Clemson University will verify that a transient student has taken the appropriate prerequisites for a given course. Clemson University also will not advise transient students regarding requirements of the student's home institution. It is the responsibility of the transient student to research and take appropriate prerequisites for any Clemson University course and to obtain appropriate advising from his/her home institution regarding transfer credit and all other advising matters related to the home institution's requirements.

Upon certification by the student to the department responsible for the course that s/he meets the prerequisites for a particular course, the student will be allowed to register for the class in question. This action is <u>not</u> verification by Clemson that a transient student will be prepared to take a given course.

By signing below, the student acknowledges that he/she has checked all of the prerequisites for the courses s/he will take during the term. The student also understands that summer classes move at a faster pace than classes that occur in a regular term. It is the student's sole responsibility to determine that s/he will be prepared to handle both the material and the course load of courses for which s/he enrolls during a given term at Clemson University.

It is also important for transient students to take note of Clemson University withdrawal deadlines because they happen very early in the semester and impact whether a student can receive any tuition refund. Withdrawal after a designated date results in a prorated refund of tuition until a certain date when there is no refund granted as stated in the Refund Schedule for Academic Fees (<a href="https://www.clemson.edu/finance/student-financials/refunds">https://www.clemson.edu/finance/student-financials/refunds</a>).
