If you would like to attend PWE this summer, complete, detach and mail the application form. You must have a score of 27 or above on the ACT Math or a score of 640 or above on the SAT Math AND have attended a virtual freshmen orientation prior to PWE.

The PWE will take place July 5-24, 2020. The cost is \$825.00. Payments will be finalized upon acceptance to the program. SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE THROUGH DUKE ENERGY TO ATTEND.

NOTE: All incoming freshmen must have completed the admission process by May 1, 2020 to be considered an accepted student at Clemson University.

Applications must be postmarked by May 22, 2020 and accepted students will be notified by June 12. If you have any questions, please call or email.
