Academics

You'll find a variety of engineering and math classes. These introductory classes review some of the necessary objectives for achieving success at the college level. They're designed to identify areas that may require further review while providing insight on real classroom experiences.

- General Engineering learn about the many engineering majors at Clemson and find tools to help you in your first year of engineering.
- Calculus, Physics, Chemistry and Research prepare for college level classes with these review courses.
- Introduction to research and graduate school

Students will be able to engage with fellow students, current faculty and staff. There will also be opportunities to attend workshops on topics such as undergraduate research, graduate school, study skills and time management, and adjusting to college. Virtual industry tours will also be available.

Prior to the start of classes on August 18, 2021, students will be given the opportunity to attend a Meet and Greet where they will meet PEER & WISE staff and mentors.

Apply Today

If you would like to attend PWE this summer, complete, detach and mail the application form. SAT and ACT scores are not required but if you have taken them you must have an ACT score of 27 or above or an SAT MATH score of 640 or above. If you did not take the ACT or SAT, you must have completed the Clemson Math Placement Test (CMPT) with a score of 65. The cost of the CMPT is \$25 for the first attempt. You are allowed two additional attempts at \$10 each.

The PWE will take place July 7-30, 2021. The cost is \$1950. Payments will be finalized upon acceptance to the program. 50 full scholarships are available through Duke Energy for students that meet the requirements.

NOTE: All incoming freshmen must have completed the admission process by May 7, 2021 to be considered an accepted student at Clemson University.

Applications must be postmarked by May 28, 2021 and accepted students will be notified by June 18.
