Clemson University's Robert H. Brooks Sports Science Institute opens the call for 2026 Markvan Bellamy Brooks undergraduate scholars in eligible departments and units at Clemson University. Endowed in memory of Robert H. Brooks' late son, Mark Brooks '91, this fund provides scholarships to undergraduate students with a passion for sports. 10 scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 each will be awarded to students for the 2026-2027 academic year.

Eligibility & Requirements

Departments and units at Clemson University with faculty or staff who have been members of the Institute for one year or more (as of July 1, 2026) are eligible to nominate one student each for a Brooks Scholarship. Of those nominations, the Institute will select ten final awardees.

Eligible areas at Clemson include the Departments of Parks, Recreation and Tourism Management, Communication, Marketing, Automotive, Bioengineering, Graphic Communications, Educational and Organizational Leadership Development, Teaching and Learning, Psychology, Industrial Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Physics and Astronomy, Chemistry, Food, Nutrition and Packaging Sciences, School of Accounting, Division of Human-Centered Computing and Clemson 4-H.

Students must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Junior or Senior at Clemson University during the 2026-2027 academic year.
- Provide evidence of academic, athletic, volunteer, internship or work experience in sport.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Meet any additional requirements as set forth by their department or unit.

Application packets should include the following materials:

- A resume, the student's CUID and evidence of a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- A 500-word essay demonstrating accomplishment in sport (academic, athletic, volunteer, internship or work) and future aspirations related to the field of sports.
- A letter of recommendation from a current faculty fellow in that department or unit.

The application packet for one nominee in each area should be emailed to Kayla Rogers at krroge2@clemson.edu no later than March 31, 2026. The Institute will make final selections and clear the nominees with Financial Aid before awards are announced near the end of the spring term.
