

SUMMER RESIDENTIAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP CAMP
JULY 20-24, 2026
RULES AND REGULATIONS

Parents should expect a phone call if campers violate camp rules. Seriousness of behavior may result in immediate expulsion from camp.

- Campers must report safety concerns or inappropriate behavior immediately to their Counselor, Mentor, Camp Managers or Camp Director.
- Possession or use of tobacco or vaping products is **strictly prohibited** at all times during camp.
- Possession or use of alcohol is **strictly prohibited** at all times during camp.
- Possession or use of firearms, knives, weapon components, bows and arrows, paintball guns, slingshots, explosives, fireworks, candles, halogen lamps, incense, flammable liquids, dangerous chemicals, propelled missiles, pepper spray, or similar items is **strictly prohibited**.
- Campers must always be accompanied by a staff member when walking between locations.
- Taking photos or videos of campers, staff, or personal belongings without permission is prohibited.
- Inappropriate language or behavior is not allowed.
- Phones must be silenced during speaker sessions; usage should be minimal during these times.
- Inappropriate or unauthorized use of the Clemson Guest Wi-Fi is prohibited.
- LCD screens must be used for camp-related and professional purposes only during work sessions.
- Inappropriate, explicit, illegal, or offensive content may not be viewed, streamed, downloaded, or shared at any time during camp.
- Shirts and shoes are required except in residence hall rooms. Sneakers are recommended for evening activities and walking to and from the dorms and dining hall to the Launchpad.
- Casual, comfortable, class-appropriate dress is expected.
- Sleeping during camp activities is not permitted. If you are feeling unwell, please report it to a counselor.
- Campers may not have visitors during camp, except during check-in and check-out.
- **Campers are financially responsible for any property damage they cause, including a \$100 charge for lost room keys.**
- No on-site parking is provided, except during check-in and check-out.
- Scooters, bikes, and skateboards are not allowed at camp or inside residence halls.
- Campers are expected to be on time and participate in all scheduled activities.
- Cooking or food preparation in dorms is prohibited. Meals will be provided at McAlister Dining Hall.
- Only dry, non-odorous, non-perishable snacks are permitted in residence hall rooms. **No peanuts or peanut products.**

- Campers are not allowed to leave the dorms to purchase food or order food delivery. Vending machines are available inside the dorms and may be used only when accompanied by a counselor.
- Garbage must be disposed of properly, and trash bags will be provided in the dorm rooms.
- Campers are not permitted to enter residence halls or residential floors designated for the opposite gender **at any time**.
- Pets are not permitted. Service animals are allowed per Clemson University regulations.
- Curfew is 10 PM to 7 AM. Campers must remain in their assigned rooms during this time.
- Evening Staff will conduct a room check at 10:00 p.m. to ensure all assigned campers are in their rooms and accounted for.
- Campers are not permitted to drive or ride in camp golf carts or other camp-owned motorized vehicles. Golf cart transportation will be provided only in emergency situations.
- Campers may only be dropped off and picked up by authorized individuals during the Clemson University camp registration process. Campers will only be released to those approved individuals.
